The Parent Mentor Program is a part of the mfiCare program, which aims to train and support parents of babies in the ICN to be the primary caregiver and partner in the care team. A Parent Mentor is someone who has been through the NICU experience and is interested in receiving training to provide peer-to-peer support to parents currently going through the NICU journey. To be a mentor, you must be at least one year removed from your NICU experience. We are looking for parents that have had a wide range of experiences in the NICU and come from diverse backgrounds. Mentors should have good communication skills, be a good listener and enjoy building relationships with other parents.
